ATTENTION: RESIDENTS OF LOWER OXFORD TOWNSHIP


The Supervisors of Lower Oxford Township have declared a disaster situation exists as a result of the COVID-19 (Corona Virus).

Residents of the area involved are urged to follow the following procedure:

- Avoid any unnecessary public interaction such as large gathering and events, conferences, and recreational activities (i.e., the gym, parks, movie theaters, and shopping malls, etc.)
- What you should do at home:
 - Cover coughs or sneezes with your elbow. Do Not Use Your Hands!
 - Wash hands often with soap and water for at least twenty seconds. Use an alcohol sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
 - Clean surfaces frequently, including countertops, light switches, cell phones, remotes, and other frequently touched items.
 - Contain: If you are sick, stay home until you are feeling better and free of fever for at least 24 hours.


