

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING LOWER OXFORD TOWNSHIP TO ESTABLISH A REASONABLE AND SAFE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT FOR TOWNSHIP ROADS KNOWN AS DALTON ROAD AND TOBY WAY AS THE ROADS ARE LOCATED IN LOWER OXFORD TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ORDAINED AND HEREAFTER ADOPTED by the Board of Supervisors of Lower Oxford Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, under authority of "Vehicles" Act No. 81, 1976 effective July 1977, Title 75 of Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes annotated Section 3362 as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of Lower Oxford Township in accordance with 75 P.C.S.A. Section 3362(a)(1.2) finds that an engineering investigation was not necessary for the two roads by reason of the following:

1. The roads are in a residence district, the highways are not numbered traffic routes, and are functionally classified by the Department of Motor Vehicles as local highways.

Section 2. Accordingly, the Board of Supervisors has determined then, in accordance with statutory authority, that the maximum and safe reasonable speed on Dalton Road from Township Road to Toby Way and Toby Way its entire length is 25 miles per hour.

Section 3. In accordance with the above identified information, the speed limit is established for the road as identified above as being the safe and reasonable speed for said road.

Section 4. Penalty. Any person violating this Ordinance is in violation of Section 3362 of 75 P.C.S.A. Motors Vehicles and is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$35.00. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than 5 miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of \$2.00 per mile for each mile in excess of 5 miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.
