ORDINANCE NO. 2011-7

**AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 4-2009 AND 1-2011
ESTABLISHING MANDATORY SEWER CONNECTION
AND USE REGULATIONS FOR A SPECIFIC LIMITED
AND DEFINED AREA AND ESTABLISHING THE
OXFORD AREA SEWER AUTHORITY AS AGENT FOR
THE PURPOSES OF IMPLEMENTATION OF CERTAIN
ORDINANCE REQUIREMENTS.**

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lower Oxford, Chester County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1 – Purpose.

The purpose of this amendment is to repeal the provisions of Ordinance No. 1-2011 in its entirety, the full section or special provision:

Section 2 – Repealed.

Section 1. Purpose. Creation of a moratorium.

Section 3. Use of public sewer system.

A-1, 13, 14, and 15.

Section 3 – Reaffirmation.

The above section numbers contained in Ordinance No. 1-2011 are hereby repealed. The purpose of this repealing is to remove the moratorium placed on mandatory connection by Ordinance 1-2011.

By means of this Ordinance all of the provisions of Ordinance No. 4-2009 are affirmed.

Section 5 - Severability

If any sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Lower Oxford Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 6 - Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective within five (5) days of adoption.
